Daylight Saving Time Ends

On Sunday, November 2, 2014, at 2:00 a.m., clocks are turned **backward one hour** to local standard time. Sunrise and sunset will be about one hour earlier on November 2 than the day before, and there will be more light in the morning.

Always remember to *spring forward* and *fall back*. Twenty-seven years ago, the people from Energizer Batteries and the nation's firefighters came up with an idea which connected two unrelated activities: changing

clocks for Daylight Saving Time and changing the batteries in smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors.

Most of the United States observes DST except for Hawaii and most of Arizona, as well as US Virgin Islands, Guam, and Puerto Rico.

5211 Central Avenue, Riverside

This 1888 Victorian farmhouse (the "Henry M. Streeter House") is Riverside Historic Landmark No. 88, and was built on 40 acres of alfalfa and citrus property for Mr. Henry Streeter, a state senator, who drafted legislation which led to the creation of Riverside County in 1893.

The current owners are only the 4th family to own this home in 126 years, and this was the last working farm in Riverside.

This 4 bedroom, 2 bathroom, approx 2300 sq ft home (which also has a guest house) sits upon one acre now, is on par with The Heritage House as far as museum quality originality, in addition to tasteful modern day conveniences such as a remodeled chef's kitchen, remodeled bathrooms, central air/heat, and a master bedroom suite with walk-in closet.

The attic (third floor) is large enough to convert into more living square footage if necessary.

Almost one acre of land, it's dotted with 24 citrus trees, pomegranate, mulberry, loquat and fig, and the driveway is lined with the "Ragged Robin" rosebushes (introduced in 1825) that also line historical Victoria Avenue.

The property has a conditional use permit for a tea house (known as "The Streeter Tea House").



The Riverside Police Department is offering FREE Smart Medical ID bracelets to Riverside residents through their Get Home Safe program. The bracelet is worn by at-risk persons (Alzheimer's and other cognitive impairment disorders) and contains a unique code that is linked to an electronic profile with current photo,



emergency medical info (allergies, etc.) and emergency contact info. This info is used by Police, Fire, and Emergency Medical Personnel to help identify a found person that may not be able to provide information about themselves.
